- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act2; and,
- be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.

Tasks and Responsibilities:

Sierra Club Ontario is looking for an energetic, creative, and hardworking individual to help with Chapter outreach and campaign-specific initiatives. The Environmental Outreach Coordinator will be responsible for assisting with both online and offline outreach activities, include digital communications and community outreach. The student will also be responsible

for occasional research and writing tasks specific to Sierra Club Ontario's campaigns, as required.

Job Description:

- Coordinating and organizing campaign-oriented events, promoting attendance for speaker events, promoting public participation in environmental outreach, education and stewardship workshops
- Research and writing materials with an environmental sustainability focus, particularly relating to Sierra Club Ontario's programs in green energy, Greenbelt, Great Lakes, and other local issues like conservation and pollution prevention
- Assist in developing and executing digital communications strategy including website content creation, social media marketing strategy, and membership e-newsletters
- Assist in promoting Sierra Club's membership growth strategy and strengthening member relations through online and public outreach methods
- Assist in recruiting, training, and coordinating campaign volunteers
- Fundraising assistance including identifying grants and sponsorship opportunities, and general administrative support as needed

Qualifications:

- Desired educational background in: environmental science, environmental studies, public policy, sustainability, biology, geography, and marketing and communications or media
- Experience in community outreach, research, writing, marketing, and/or fundraising
- Computer skills especially GIS, graphic design (Adobe Creative Suite), and web development an asset
- Experience in Sierra Club Ontario's priority campaign areas (Green energy, Great Lakes/water, and Greenbelt/conservation) considered an asset
- Exceptional organizational and time management skills
- Ability to work well both independently and in a team
- Ability to think critically and creatively to solve problems
- Ability to pay strong attention to detail
- Multilingualism would be an asset
